**Re: Term I Examinations**

2017-18 Term I Examinations will take place on January 17 - 21, 2019. The examination schedule and examination policies are available on the school's website. Attached please also find guidelines for examinations from the Discipline Committee. Please follow the schedule and observe the guidelines closely. Please also notice the following points:

**Sport Activities at School**

All sport activities at school will be suspended for the entire examination period so that students can concentrate and focus on their studies.

**On the Examination Days**

- i. All students should arrive at school not later than 8:30 a.m.
- ii. Students should stay on the G/F until 8:50 a.m. and should not enter into the examination rooms until called by an invigilator.
- iii. Academic honesty is important in exam writing. Cheating will result in receiving a zero grade or even expulsion from school.

Note:

2. Term 2 starts on Thursday, January 24, 2019.
3. Grade 9 – 10 Schoolwide Project (In class lessons) will start on January 25 - 31, 2019.
4. Term I Supplementary Exams will start on January 25, 28, 29, and 30 (after school at 2:30 – 4:30p.m.)

**Discipline Committee Guidelines for Examinations**

1. There will be absolutely no talking without permission.
2. Students must not communicate with other students by gesture, hand signal and so on. Students who do, will be treated the same as if they had been talking without permission.
3. Students must not make any type of noise such as whistling, knuckle crunching, pen tapping, repeated yawning and so on. Students who do, will be treated the same as if they had been talking without permission.
4. Students must be in proper school uniform. Students not dressed properly will be sent home without writing their examination.
5. Students will not be allowed toilet breaks, except under exceptional circumstances.

Talking without permission during an examination may result in the immediate expulsion of the student from the examination room, and/or the student will be

reported to the Discipline Committee for academic penalty assessment. The examination may be disqualified and a grade of zero recorded, or the grade may be reduced at the discretion of the Discipline Committee.
