Re: Term I Examinations

To: All Students

The Term I Examinations Schedule will be modified to suit the half-day session requirement. The exams will take place on January 13-17, 2022. The examination schedule has been posted on the school's website. Attached please also find guidelines for examinations from the Discipline Committee. Students are advised to follow the schedule and observe the guidelines closely. Please also notice the following points:

Sport Activities at School

All sport activities at school will be suspended during exam period as this may help students to concentrate and focus on their study.

On the Examination Days

- i. All students should arrive at school not later than 8:30 a.m.
- ii. Students should stay on the G/F until 8:50 a.m. and should not enter into the examination rooms until called by an invigilator.
- iii. Academic honesty is important in exam writing. Cheating will result in receiving a zero grade or even expulsion from school.

Note: January 19 is the Marking & PD Day for teachers, there will be no lessons for students. All students should return back to school in the morning on Thursday, January 20th to review their exams and to check their grades. Term 2 will begin on January 21 and there will be Chinese New Year Celebration activities in that afternoon.

Discipline Committee Guidelines for Examinations

1. There will be absolutely no talking without permission.
2. Students must not communicate with other students by gesture, hand signal and so on. Students who do, will be treated the same as if they had been talking without permission.
3. Students must not make any type of noise such as whistling, knuckle crunching, pen tapping, repeated yawning and so on. Students who do, will be treated the same as if they had been talking without permission.
4. Students must be in proper school uniform. Students not dressed properly will be sent home without writing their examination.
5. Students will not be allowed toilet breaks, except under exceptional circumstances.

Talking without permission during an examination may result in the immediate expulsion of the student from the examination room, and/or the student will be reported to the Discipline Committee for academic penalty assessment. The examination may be disqualified and a grade of zero recorded, or the grade may be reduced at the discretion of the Discipline Committee.

Additional requirements for online exam takers

1. Students must show their full face within the video at all times during the exam
2. Students must use a second device (example: phone or iPad) to clearly show their full computer screen and work station. This device should be to the side of the student and approximately 0.5 meter away.
