Dear Parents/Guardians,

The 2022-23 academic year will end on June 24 and Term II assessments are approaching quickly. Despite this year's disruption, I hope your child has had a fruitful year in Concordia International School. Please note the following upcoming arrangements and school events:

- 1) The Term II examinations run from Wednesday, June 14 to Monday, June 19. During the exam period, students are required to be at school. Both the "Examination Policies" and "Examination Schedule" are available on the school's website.
- 2) June 20-21 are marking & professional development days for teachers. There will be no school for students.
- 3) Friday, June 23
 - All students are to return back to school as usual and in school uniform in the morning to get their draft copies of report cards. There will be a Closing Ceremony in the Chapel at 11:30 a.m. There is no school in the afternoon.
 - Graduation will take place for the graduating class at 3:00 P.M in the afternoon. Graduates need to come back by 12 noon for their graduation photograph.
 - Students of lower grades are welcomed to attend the Graduation Ceremony to support their seniors.
 - **Parents of Grade 12 are cordially invited to attend their children's Graduation Ceremony. All parents should arrive at 2:30 P.M**
 - The Graduation Dinner will take place at the Sheraton Hong Kong Hotel & Towers
- 4) Supplementary examinations will be arranged for some selected students from June 26 to 29 (10:00 -11:00 a.m.). Since it is not foreseeable who will or who will not take the supplementary examinations, it is advisable that you do not make any summer activity plans for your child during this period. If your child is not required to take a supplementary examination, then he/she will not have to come back to school after June 23. Your child's report card will be sent to you by mail in the middle of July.

- 5) The Summer Tutorial Classes (for those who have failed no more than 2 core subjects in Term 1 and/or Term 2) will run from July 3 to July 14 (for 10 days at 2 hours each) at a specified EDB registered learning center. Should you anticipate that your child might need to take one or more of these classes for promotion in 2023-24, you should not plan any summer activities for him/her during this period. If you need more information regarding missing credits and assistance on the learning center, please do not hesitate to contact Ms. Wu at the General Office.
- 6) *For the attention of Grade 10 students & their parents: Our current Grade 11-12 curriculum only allow students to study 2 science courses during their grade 11-12 years. Chemistry is offered every year, but Physics or Biology will only be offered in alternate years. In 2023-24, AP Biology is tentatively offered. Students must inform the General Office so they can be placed on the appropriate class list if they need a Biology/Physics credit for their further studies.
- 7) In 2023-24, the school also plans to start AP Human Geography. If the course is successfully started, students can study AP Psychology or AP Human Geography in alternate years (similar to AP Biology and AP Physics I in Science).

Please supervise and encourage your child to prepare for the upcoming examinations.

The summer vacation starts formally from July 1, 2023 and returning students will resume class on August 14, 2023.
