(a) PSAT/NMSQT Exam and Mid-Term Break:

(c) Activity Week and Overseas Trip(s)

As planned in the school calendar, a week in November is dedicated for experiential learning where students learn outside of the classroom, such as engaging in overseas activities or at the local level. Overseas trips have always been a part of the school's activity week since 2009. The trips are based on three revolving themes of Cultural Exchanges, Adventures, and Service Learning and prior to Covid-19, the school has organized various trips (East Asia, SE Asia, Australia, Middle East, and Europe). This year's theme is on Service Learning and our trip coordinator has arranged an introduction with the trip organizer via zoom during the Open House. Additional information with deposit and reply slips have also been sent out to students who are interested in the trips. We hope to regain this momentum where students can learn outside the classrooms and take this opportunity to bond with their peers. For students who are not interested in the overseas trip, the school has also organized local daily and overnight camp activities. Experiential learning in Activity Week is a part of the school curriculum. Therefore, it compulsory for students to join and absences will be counted toward the attendance requirement.
